Important dates

Abstract submission deadline: May 25th, 2019

Abstract Acceptance decision: June 30th, 2019

Registration deadline: September 1st, 2019

Venue

The conference venue will be the Medical Scientific and Educational Center of the Lomonosov Moscow State University (Lomonosovsky Prospect, 27, b.10, Moscow).

Sections

Two sections will include 6-8 presentations. The time for talk presentations will be maximum 10 minutes. Time will be allotted for questions.

Official language of the symposium: English

Category of the participation

There are categories of participation:

1. Only participation without publication
2. Short Talk Presentations
3. Poster Presentations

You should specify your preferred category of participation.

The submitting author will be informed in due time whether their abstract or article has been accepted and to which category it was assigned.

As the number of slots for short talk presentations is limited, please understand that some presenters may be asked to adapt short talk presentations to posters.

For both short talks and posters the names and affiliations of ALL authors should be included in the abstract, i.e. department, institution, city, country.

Abstract requirement

Abstracts should be written according to the instructions below and will be reviewed for acceptance based upon their scientific merit.

Abstracts should not be longer than 300 words, not including the title, author names and affiliations. Submitters will be informed if their abstracts have been accepted, and to which category it was assigned, by the programme committee.

The following information needs to be included in the submission:

Title of the abstract,

3-5 key words

Type of the study presented (options: empirical, theoretical review, methodological or meta-analysis, description of an intervention; Case-study; Other)

Format of presentation (options: Short Talk, Poster).

Literature references should be included in the square brackets after the quotation (not more than 3-4 references).

Poster requirement

Poster size - 100x80 cm. No more than two posters per speaker are allowed to participate in the poster session.

Article requirement

Articles should be no longer than 3000 words, not including the title, author names and affiliations. Submitters will be informed if their articles have been accepted by the program committee.

The following information needs to be included in the submission:

Title of the article,

5-8 key words

Type of the study presented (options: empirical, theoretical review, methodological or meta-analysis, description of an intervention; Case-study; Other)

Format of presentation (options: Short Talk, Poster).

Literature references should be included in the square brackets after the quotation (not more than 20 references)

Publication of materials

All accepted abstracts and articles will be published in the electronic version of the proceedings of the international Conference "Multidisciplinary aspects of a personalized approach to mental health problems". Materials selected by the Scientific Committee may be published as articles in one of the international journals indexed in Scopus.

Participation fee

Participation fee is 100 € up to September 1., 2019.

Participation fee includes: abstract publication, conference dinner, welcoming banquet, congress materials and abstract book, refreshments during breaks, verified certificate of attendance.

The fee will not be refunded if the cancellation of the participation occurs after 10 September 2019.

Reduced 50% of the charge is possible only on the basis of a written agreement with the congress organizer and will be made after completing the congress.
