Category of the participation

There are categories of participation:

1. Only participation without publication
2. Only publication without participation
3. Short Talk Presentations
4. Poster Presentations

You should specify your preferred category of participation.

The submitting author will be informed in due time, whether their abstract or article has been accepted and which category it was assigned to.

Please notice, that the number of oral presentations is limited by each section's duration. The final decision regarding the type of presentation is the responsibility of the Scientific Committee and Organizing Committee. For both short talks and posters the names and affiliations of ALL authors should be included in the abstract, i.e. Department, institution, city, country.

Abstract requirement

Abstracts should be written according to the instructions below and will be reviewed for acceptance based upon their scientific merit.

Abstracts should be no longer than 300 words, not including the title, author names and affiliations.

Submitters will be informed if their abstracts have been accepted, and in which category, by the program committee.

The following information needs to be included in the submission:

Title of the abstract,

3-5 key words

Type of the presentation (options: empirical, theoretical review, methodological or meta-analysis, description of an intervention; Case-study; Other)

Format of presentation (options: Short Talk, Poster).

References to the literature should be placed in the article in square brackets after the quotation (not more than 3-4 references)

Poster requirement

Poster size - 100x80 cm. No more than two posters per speaker are allowed to participate in the poster session.

Article requirement

Articles should be no longer than 3000 words, not including the title, author names and affiliations.

Submitters will be informed if their articles have been accepted by the program committee.

The following information needs to be included in the submission:

Title of the article,

5-8 key words

Type of the presentation (options: empirical, theoretical review, methodological or meta-analysis, description of an intervention; Case-study; Other)

Format of presentation (options: Short Talk, Poster).

References to the literature should be placed in the article in square brackets after the quotation (not more than 20 references)

Publication of materials

All accepted abstracts and articles will be published in the electronic version of the materials of the International Conference "Multidisciplinary aspects of a personalized approach to mental health problems". Materials selected by the Scientific Committee may be published as articles in one of the international journals indexed in Scopus.

Participation fee

The participation fee is 100 € up to September 1, 2019.

Participation fee includes: publication of abstracts, conference dinner, welcoming banquet, congressional materials and book of summaries, refreshments during breaks, verified certificate of attendance

The fee will not be refunded if the cancellation of the participation occurs after 10 September 2019. Reduced 50% of the charge is possible only on the basis of a written agreement with the organizer of the congress and will be made after the end of the congress.
